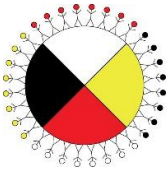

It is with this vision we are honoured to have the role in the planning, organizing and implementing of programming for families with children between the ages 0-6 years. As a youth led agency we will incorporate, language, culture, land, community and nutrition programming, all infused with the traditional knowledge our people.

Located at Kapapamahchakwew - Wandering Spirit School, 16 Phin Ave and under the direct supervision of the ENAGB EarlyON Supervisor the **ENAGB EarlyON Program Staff** will be responsible for the;

- Supporting the creation and/or researching indigenous curriculum and lesson plans that promote education on language, culture, land, community and nutrition.
- Delivering programming that is suitable for children 0 – 6 year old and their families.
- Delivering prenatal programming for families.
- Ensuring a culturally safe, trauma-informed approach that is responsive to the diverse communities of our Indigenous children and families.
- Supporting the setup of the programming space.
- Assisting with the marketing and promotion of the programs.
- Interacting directly with the children and their caregivers, providing quality care.
- Providing supports to the caregivers of the children.
- Supervising and coordinating activities.
- Working as a team with co-workers and parents is essential to the success.
- Ability to develop and implement programs that support and promote the physical, cognitive, emotional and social development of children.
- Read each individual child's files in his/her program and be knowledgeable about his/her medical and developmental histories.
- Interact with families to encourage their involvement in activities.
- Plan, prepare, and implement daily activities (indoor/outdoor) as they relate to the curriculum.



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- Work with team to form a positive, supportive team atmosphere.
- Ensure confidentiality of privileged information.
- Ensuring a team approach.
- Identifying policies and procedures of the program.
- Adhere to the policies and procedures of the ENAGB Youth Program.
- Other related duties as it relates to this position.

- Over two years of experience working with children between 0-6 years and families.

- Fluent in an indigenous language and knowledge of Indigenous cultures.
- Able to work evenings and weekends.
- Adequate energy and ability to meet the physical demands of the job.
- A valid Standard First Aid and CPR.
- A cleared Criminal Reference check with Vulnerable Sector Screening.
- A positive, fun-loving attitude.
- The ability to work as a team and self-motivated.
